Welcome to this addition of our newsletter, the year is rapidly passing and the issues continue to surface, with James Hardie again saying how tough business is.

James Hardie Industries says it will cut its asbestos fund contribution by up to \$US11 million (\$A10.42 million) in 2012 after it carries out further internal restructuring. The building materials maker, which shifted its domicile from the Netherlands to Ireland last year, says it expects to book a \$32.6 million tax charge due to a 'simplification' of its corporate structure.

James Hardie said the \$32.6 million tax charge associated with its restructuring would be included in the fiscal 2011 accounts and payable in fiscal 2012.

'This charge will not impact the contribution to the Asbestos Injuries Compensation Fund (AICF) in July 2011, although it is likely to reduce the contribution to the AICF in July 2012 by up to \$US11.4 million,' James Hardie said (sourced from Sky News)

Another concern is a recent decision handed down, in NSW, regarding Asbestos Related Nervous Shock. it appears that James Hardie is the only defendant in Australia which is now absolved of liability in relation to those claims. AVA is working with others to try and have this anomaly rectified.

2 Eggs, 2 Tablespoons Flour, Salt and Pepper


Put potatoes in a bowl and squeeze the juice out

KATZ KORNER

Lawyers have successfully obtained compensation on behalf of widows of former Commonwealth employees. In each case the former Commonwealth employee died of Mesothelioma. Compensation was payable to these widows as dependants of their husband at the time of their death.

A dependant is classified as a spouse who is living with a former Commonwealth employee at the time of their death. Children are also dependants if they are living with the Commonwealth employee and are financially dependent in any way.

The compensation paid included a payment for out of pocket expenses and funeral expenses. The claims on behalf of these widows were made following their husbands death.

If you have a loved one WHO has died of an asbestos disease as a result of employment with the Commonwealth, it is important to obtain legal advice as to your rights to compensation.
